



WAIRAU RIVER

CHARDONNAY 2008

Marlborough's Wairau River (pronounced why-raow) has carved an intricate braided pattern of channels on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978. Meticulous management of the family estate ensures only exceptional parcels of fruit are destined for the flagship Wairau River label.

A fruitful nose of nectarine and citrus integrates with background floral and savoury notes. Those characteristics are generously translated through the palate with lime, ripe peach and biscuit flavours complemented by the subtle nutty influence of French oak. Enjoy this wine with mouth-watering morsels and mirth.
