SAUVIGNON BLANC 2008

Marlborough's Wairau River (pronounced why-raow) has carved an intricate braided pattern of channels on its path to the Pacific Ocean. It is on these riverbanks that Phil and Chris Rose planted their first vines in 1978. Meticulous management of the family estate ensures only exceptional parcels of fruit are destined for the flagship Wairau River label.

The nose is very aromatic displaying ripe passion fruit, tropical fruits and floral notes. The palate is exuberant and well fruited with a soft mid palate and refreshing acidity. Savour with high jinks and convivial company.
